**Dr. Susan Nagele**, Maryknoll Lay Missioner, will give a presentation on her 34 years of medical mission in East Africa (Tanzania, South Sudan, Kenya), where she served as a family physician to those marginalized in society and our global community. Her medical services were often provided in war zones, while facing challenges of limited resources.

She will be joined by two other Maryknoll Lay Missioners – **Karen Bortvedt** (Cambodia 2013-2017), and **Sam Stanton** (Chile, U.S. 1985-2018).
